PURPLE BEER LINE CLEANER

DIRECTIONS: Prepare a solution of 50ml of **PURPLE BEER LINE CLEANER** in 5 litres of water. Drain all beer from the system. Draw the solution into the system until it is full, and purple fluid is issued from each line. Leave for 20 minutes. A change of colour from purple to a dirty greenish state indicates loss of cleaning properties following contact with soil, and fresh solution should be drawn into the equipment until the fluid remains purple. Allow to remain in contact for ten minutes. Draw off the solution, and if colourless, add more solution. Repeat as necessary until the purple colour remains stable, and retain in lines for a few minutes. Retention of a purple colour indicates that the lines are clean. Flush lines with plenty of water, until completely colourless. Beer lines should be cleaned on a weekly basis.

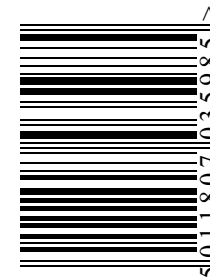
CAUTION: Spillages should be diluted with water and flushed into the drain.
Store in containers as supplied, with closures tightly secured, and under cool conditions.
Do not leave in equipment overnight
This product should not be used on nylon equipment, nor on aluminium or soft alloys.
Dilute only with cold water.
